

Existing Operational Certificate Clause:

1. AUTHORIZED DISCHARGES

1.1 This section applies to the discharge of municipal solid waste and other refuse specifically authorized in writing by the Director to the Campbell Hill Landfill (formerly known as the Cache Creek Landfill Extension). The site reference number for the overall discharge to the site is E305678.

1.1.1 The maximum rate of discharge is 750,000 tonnes per year.

1.1.5 The characteristics of the discharge must be municipal solid waste as defined in the *Environmental Management Act* and other wastes as specifically authorized in writing by the Director.

Amended Operational Certificate Clause: (additions highlighted in red)

1. AUTHORIZED DISCHARGES

1.1 This section applies to the discharge of municipal solid waste and other refuse specifically authorized in writing by the Director to the Campbell Hill Landfill (formerly known as the Cache Creek Landfill Extension). The site reference number for the overall discharge to the site is E305678.

1.1.1 The maximum rate of discharge is 750,000 tonnes per year, including:

(a) A maximum of 100,000 tonnes per year of Contaminated Soil;

(b) A maximum of 70,000 tonnes per year of Auto Shred Residue.

1.1.5 The characteristics of the discharge must be municipal solid waste as defined in the *Environmental Management Act* and other wastes as specifically authorized in writing by the Director, including:

(a) Contaminated Soil;

(b) Auto Shred Residue;

GLOSSARY:

"Contaminated Soil" means soil in which the concentration of a substance is greater than or equal to the lowest applicable industrial land use standard referred to in section 41(1)(a) of the Contaminated Sites Regulation, B.C. Reg. 375/96;

"Auto Shred Residue" means industrial waste from the "vehicle dismantling and recycling industry" as defined in the Waste Discharge Regulation, B.C. Reg. 320/2004 and Vehicle Dismantling and Recycling Industry Environmental Planning Regulation, B.C. Reg 200/2007;
